
Names and Profiles of Panelists at the Green Hydrogen for Youth session

Ms. Shriya Rai



Shriya Rai is a youth sustainability leader and a National Geographic Young Explorer. As the founder of the Sashakt Bharat Initiative, Shriya raised 35,000\$ and mobilized 40+ local partners to organize sustainability education workshops, reaching out to 3000 youth leaders nationwide. She has led global communication trainings and capacity-building programs as an EE trainer through her association with WWF, GEEP, and the US State Department. She is driven by her vision of making sustainability education crucial to climate action efforts through programs that integrate traditional knowledge, linguistic expression, and regional contextualities. Shriya recently graduated as an Erasmus Mundus scholar from the Universities of Leipzig and Ghent and continues to be involved as a youth trainer with AICAPD and NAAEE.

Sailesh is the Co-Founder of Youth For Green Hydrogen, an initiative of Youth of India Foundation (www.youthofindia.org.in) which brought together a network of young people from 78 countries bringing together 135 institutions with 0.5 Million registered participants, with a reach of 24.35 Million. He has been invited as a Featured Youth Speaker along with UN Climate Change High-Level Champion for COP27, Hon. Minister of Republic of Indonesia for the Green Hydrogen Assembly co-hosted by Government of Spain.

Sailesh chaired the world's first youth declaration on Green Hydrogen and presented it among the world leaders in the Assembly which was adapted by an absolute resolution.
